# SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance will designate a PetPals of Texas event on May 21, 2005 as an official City of San Antonio co-sponsored event, on a one-time basis, as directed through a Council Consideration Request (CCR) memorandum, dated February 24, 2005 sponsored by City Council Member Art Hall, District 8, and will waive associated fees.

# **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

City Council Member Art Hall, District 8, has submitted a Council Consideration Request (CCR) memorandum to designate an event with the PetPals of Texas organization as an official City of San Antonio co-sponsored event, on a one-time basis. This event, the "Bow-Wow/Meow Luau, will provide information and support to citizens owning animals across the city and will help increase awareness of responsible pet ownership. PetPals of Texas is a local non-profit organization with an established history of working with the City of San Antonio and our citizens. The event is scheduled to take place on May 21, 2005 at Eisenhower Park, which has been reserved from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. There will be free admission and entertainment. PetPals of Texas will receive a percentage of revenue from food and beverage concession booths.

PetPals of Texas requested the City to co-sponsor the event, thereby waiving certain fees in connection with the use of Eisenhower Park and security fees. With the information provided by the organization, the following costs are anticipated:

Park Reservation Fee:

\$1,000.00

To be waived

Deposit:

\$1,000.00

To be paid by PetPals

of Texas, refundable

Park Police Officer:

\$375.00

To be paid by City

- Additional security is required to be hired by PetPals of Texas at the ratio of one officer per every 200 people. The officers must be certified peace officers in uniform.
- The co-sponsored event will be covered by the City's liability insurance.

# **POLICY ANALYSIS**

The City Council Governance Committee reviewed this proposed action on Wednesday, March 2, 2005 and provided direction to staff to bring this item forward for full Council consideration. Staff has reviewed this request in order to assess the financial impact of co-sponsorship, as well as any direct benefits to the city.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The estimated total fiscal impact for this event is \$1,375.00. Park Police Officer expenses in the amount of approximately \$375.00 will be a direct expense from the General Fund. Anticipated revenue to the General Fund will be reduced by \$1,000.00 due to the fee waiver.
