SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the Interim City Manager to accept a grant award which provides an additional \$23,474.00 from the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) for the ongoing Environmental Health and Wellness Center (EHWC) Program in the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) and extends the grant period of said program through September 29, 2005. This ordinance will also revise the program budget and authorize payments for contractual services.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A number of residents living near the former KAFB and former KAFB workers have reported health problems such as rashes, headaches, nosebleeds, cancer, nervous disorders and chronic diseases (i.e. diabetes and lupus). A significant number of these residents believe that chemical exposures from the former KAFB have been the cause of these health effects. Data gathered and analyzed by federal, state and local agencies have not demonstrated a link at this time. However, residents in neighborhoods near KAFB as well as former KAFB workers still have health concerns that need to be investigated.

In order to address these concerns, the SAMHD Environmental Health and Wellness Center (EHWC) was established through an ordinance passed and approved November 2, 2000. Initial funding for the Center was obtained through the Texas Department of Health. However, since September 30, 2002, the program has been supported through a grant from ATSDR. Currently, funding from this agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services totals \$602,089.00. This ordinance will authorize the acceptance of an ATSDR grant award offering additional support of \$23,474.00 and extending the grant period through September 29, 2005.

Since its inception, the EHWC has performed 1,886 clinical health assessments of the residents in neighborhoods near KAFB and former KAFB workers. Now, in addition to a letter campaign inviting KAFB area residents into the clinic, EHWC staff is going doorto-door in the neighborhoods offering home assessments. To date 250 houses within the targeted area have been canvassed twice resulting in 33 home interview assessments being completed. In May 2005, a different neighborhood near the former KAFB will be targeted for this service.

The EHWC also has been serving participants at a Senior Nutrition Project in the target area since October 2004 and has completed 65 personal health assessments with these individuals. The assessments include blood pressure check, health counseling, medicine review, home safety recommendations, and checks for cholesterol, glucose, and hemoglobin. Referrals are also made when required.

The personnel complement remains at two, the same as last year. Payments for contractual services will continue to be made for contract respiratory therapists, physicians, registered nurses, sanitarians, epidemiologists, health educators and outside laboratories for the processing of specimens on a fee-for-service basis as needed.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance follows the City practice of utilizing Federal, State and other funds to provide public health services for the residents of our community.

FISCAL IMPACT

This ordinance will allow the City to accept an additional \$23,474.00 for the EHWC, bringing the total grant funding from ATSDR to \$625,563.00. It also extends the grant period through September 29, 2005. This should be the last change to this (now) three-year federal grant. New FY 2006 grant funding of \$317,000.00 is anticipated to continue EHWC Program activities beginning September 30, 2005.

Acceptance of this grant will place no demand on the City General Fund.

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Human Resources Department, the Office of Management and Budget, and the Finance Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD WHICH PROVIDES AN ADDITIONAL \$23,474.00 FROM THE AGENCY FOR TOXIC SUBSTANCES AND REGISTRY **FOR** THE **ONGOING** DISEASE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS CENTER PROGRAM IN THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT AND EXTENDS THE PERIOD OF SAID PROGRAM THROUGH SEPTEMBER 29, 2005; REVISING THE PROGRAM BUDGET AND **AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS FOR** CONTRACTUAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) operates the Environmental Health and Wellness Center Program, a project that provides health screenings, health education and medical referrals for residents near the former Kelly Air Force Base (KAFB) as well as former KAFB workers who have health concerns regarding potential exposure from the release of hazardous substances at the former base; and

WHEREAS, the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), a component of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services that protects the public from harmful exposures and disease related to toxic substances, provides funding for the Environmental Health and Wellness Center as needed to maintain operations; and

WHEREAS, through Ordinance 98356, passed and approved October 23, 2003, the City accepted a grant award from ATSDR totaling \$602,089.00 for the SAMHD to continue the Environmental Health and Wellness Center through September 29, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the ATSDR has now offered to extend said grant through September 29, 2005 and provide additional funding of \$23,474.00 for the program; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to accept this additional support, extend the grant period, revise the program budget and authorize payments for contractual services; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Interim City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept an additional grant award of \$23,474.00 from the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), Notice of Grant Award No. H75/ATH672047-02-3, for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to continue the ongoing Environmental Health and Wellness Center Program through September 29, 2005. A copy of the ATSDR Notice of Grant Award No. H75/ATH672047-02-3 is set out in Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. SAP Fund 26022000 has been designated for use in the accounting for the above project.

SECTION 3. The additional sum of \$23,474.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund for the Environmental Health and Wellness Center Program and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

SECTION 4. The payments previously authorized for professional services in support of said Program from SAP Fund 26022000, Cost Center 3611080001, Internal Order 136000000164, SAP GL No. 5201040 are hereby reduced from \$191,719.00 to \$127,734.00.

SECTION 5. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the Interim City Manager or the Interim City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific fund numbers, account numbers, and internal order numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. Should the grant be in an amount other than that budgeted for, or should the grant contain terms and conditions different than those currently existing, acceptance of the grant and budget will be subject to subsequent City Council ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.
