SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

The attached tabulations of bids is hereby submitted for council consideration and action. Annually at this time, bids are requested for various materials, parts and services. This ordinance includes contracts for San Antonio Library internet tutoring, American La France truck parts and service, and purchase of Blauer work uniforms.

Many bids are on a firm, non-escalating basis, while others such as petroleum related items and certain other commodities require escalation of prices during the contract period. Generally, bids reflect small increases over recent prior years, but in many cases reflect decreases.

It is recommended these contracts be approved.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Funds are not expended by this ordinance. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY 2005-2006 budget to be approved by City Council. The combined total estimated amount for contracts listed on this ordinance is approximately \$205,000.
