SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance approves an appointment to the Alamo Workforce Development Board (AWDB), also known as Alamo *Work*Source. The Committee of Six, at its May 11 meeting, recommended the following appointment: Rachel Major to fill an un-expired term in the *literacy council* category.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Pursuant to the Partnership Agreement between the principal entities and the AWDB, appointees are nominated by the Chief Elected Officials (CEO's) of the Alamo region through their representatives on the "Committee of Six." The Committee is composed of two elected officials each from the City, Bexar County and the surrounding rural area. Currently sitting on the Committee of Six for the City are Mayor Edward D. Garza, Councilman Richard Perez, Bexar County Judge Nelson W. Wolff and Commissioner Tommy Atkisson represent Bexar County. Bandera County Judge Richard A. Evans and Comal County Commissioner Jay P. Millikin represent the rural area. The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) stipulates 51 percent of the board must be private sector representatives. There are nine required categories that include organized labor, education, public employment, and vocational rehabilitation among others. The agency also requires local workforce boards to be balanced geographically to represent the entire 12 county region, by ethnicity and gender.

At its most recent meeting, the Committee of Six chose Rachel Major, Chairman, San Antonio Literacy Commission, to fill the *literacy council* vacancy.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance is a continuation of current City policy authorizing the City Council to review and approve appointments to the AWDB through the Interlocal Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials and the Alamo Workforce Development Inc. The Rural Area Judges, Bexar County Commissioners Court, as well as the San Antonio City Council, must each approve these appointments. These appointments were scheduled for approval by the Bexar County Commissioners Court on May 24, 2005 and by the Area Rural Judges on May 25, 2005.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal implication from the approval of these nominations.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with Alamo *Work*Source, Bexar County, the Area Rural Judges, the City Attorney's Office, and was approved by the Committee of Six at their meeting on May 11, 2005.
