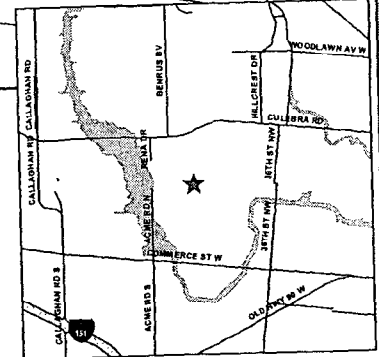

The subject property is currently vacant and located in a area that contains a mixture of single-family dwellings and two-family dwellings. The proposed multi-family district at 25 units per acre would yield a maximum of 5 units on the .2066 acre tract. The subject property is adjacent to R-5 Residential Single-Family District to the west, north, south and across the Street to the east. The MF-25 Multi-Family District would not be appropriate because vast majority of the neighborhood is zoned for single-family dwellings. The goal of the large area rezoning (Loma Park) case was to rezone properties occupied by uses incompatible with the current zoning.

Applicant: Jerry R. Musquiz

Zoning Request: "R-5" Residential Single Family District to "MF-25" Multi-Family District.

Jerry Musquiz, owner, stated he is requesting this change in zoning to allow construction for a four-plex on the subject property. He stated he has been in contact with the surrounding neighbors who are in support of this request.

Staff stated there were 39 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 2 returned in opposition and 3 returned in favor.

Everyone present, for and against having been heard and the results of the written notices having been received, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.

COMMISSION ACTION

The motion was made by Commissioner Sherrill and seconded by Commissioner Stribling to recommend approval.
