#### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

This ordinance authorizes funds in the amount of \$13,550 payable to Lawyers Title of San Antonio as escrow agent for Maria Y. Wilder for fee simple title to one parcel of land (\$3,950), and Roger A. Demers and wife, Gwen M. Demers for fee simple title to one parcel of land (\$9,000), and Title Fees (\$600); authorizing funds in the amount of \$200 for Right of Entry Fees payable to Mary Y. Wilder (\$100), and to Robert A. Demers and wife, Gwen M. Demers (\$100), for a total sum of \$13,750, in connection with the Stahl at O'Connor and Judson Reconstruction project, an authorized 1999-2004 General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds and Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) project, located in Council District 10.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This ordinance will authorize the acquisition of two parcels at Fair Market Value, which were based upon written appraisal reports prepared by Eckmann Groll, Inc., a state certified professional real estate appraisal firm.

The scope of work for this project includes the reconstruction and widening of the existing two-lane roadways to four-lanes with left turn lanes at Judson and O'Connor. Advertisement for project construction is scheduled for February 2006. Construction is anticipated to begin in May 2006, and completion projected in November 2007.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

The acquisition of this property is necessary to complete the real estate transaction for this project. Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and 1999-2004 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond Projects.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY05-FY10 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$13,750 are available from 1999-2004 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond funds and are authorized payable as follows:

WILDER FOR A RIGHT OF ENTRY AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100.00 TO ROGER A. DEMERS AND WIFE, GWEN M.
