### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance will amend the current license agreement at McAllister Park in City Council District 9 between the City of San Antonio and McAllister Park Little League, Inc. to add approximately 22.56 acres to the lease area.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Athletic organizations request to develop and utilize City property through long-term lease arrangements in order to provide practice and game fields for their league play. In exchange, the organizations provide venues for youth sports and maintain the specified park areas at their own expense. Included in the 2003 Bond program, funds are available for youth sports fields in McAllister Park. The McAllister Park Little League (MPLL) lease area will be one of the locations for the bond improvements and the lease area will need to be expanded to accept those improvements.

The MPLL has had a license in effect at McAllister Park since 1977. The original license agreement was for use and maintenance of 13.603 acres in a low area in the park. It was expanded in 1991 to include an additional area of 24.38 acres on higher elevation. The current license agreement term is from September 1, 2001 through August 31, 2006 and it contains one automatic five-year term extension. The proposed amendment will add an additional 22.56 acres to the license area for a total of 60.543 acres, so that additional fields may be constructed outside of a low-lying area currently utilized. Recent completion of San Antonio River Authority detention dam improvements have increased the occurrence of standing water in the existing lower area lease space. By increasing the higher elevation lease area, the league will eventually be able to relocate fields to the higher elevation tract. All other agreement terms remain the same.

The agreement specifies that MPLL has priority use of the fields on the dates identified on a written use schedule submitted to the Parks and Recreation Department. MPLL is permitted to

operate a concession, as long as the proceeds benefit MPLL. The group is responsible for maintenance of the fields and premises during the term of the agreement. The responsible party for the future operation of the bond improvements has not been determined (either City or MPLL).

### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

This action follows the long standing City policy of providing access to public parks for athletic organizations as a means of providing recreation programs for youth in San Antonio.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

There will be a minimal reduction to the City's General Fund through this lease agreement, due to reduced City-maintained area.

### **COORDINATION**

This action has been coordinated with the City Attorney's Office.

## FIELD USE AND MAINTENANCE LICENSE AGREEMENT MCALLISTER PARK LITTLE LEAGUE, INC AMENDMENT NO. 1

The City of San Antonio, hereinafter called "City", entered into a contract with McAllister Park Little League, Inc. hereinafter called "League", pursuant to Ordinance No. 94448, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of San Antonio on August 30, 2001. Both the City and League wish to amend said contract and hereby agree to the following amendments to said contract to be effective June 30, 2005:

- 1) Section 2.1 is amended to read as follows:
  - "5.1.1 CITY hereby designates LEAGUE as the primary user and maintainer of approximately **60.543** acres of fields in McAllister Park being part of N.C.B. 13752, San Antonio, Bexar County, and LEAGUE hereby accepts such obligations and agrees to perform such services and duties as required hereinafter."
- 2) Section 3.1 is amended to read as follows:

"3.1 CITY, for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to CITY and LEAGUE and the observance of the terms and conditions set forth hereinafter, hereby grants to LEAGUE permission to enter and use, without payment of CITY'S established field use fee, the premises described in **EXHIBITS A, B, and C** which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein. Such free use shall also apply to any fields added in the future pursuant to paragraph 2.2 hereinbefore.


