SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low, qualified bid by Amstar Construction, Inc., a SBE/MBE/WBE firm, to perform construction work in connection with the Woodlawn Lake Park Gym ADA Modifications and Park Improvements Project in City Council District 7 for the base bid of \$1,500,000.00 and bid alternates 1, 2, and 4 for a total amount of \$1,661,800.00; authorizes the execution of a standard construction contract; allocates \$122,081.64 for construction contingency, and \$1,600.00 for bid advertising and printing fees, for a total amount of \$1,785,481.64; authorizes appropriations of \$271,400.00 from 1999-2004 Park Bond funds, \$500,000.00 from 2002 Certificates of Obligation, and \$1,014,081.64 from 2003-2007 Park Bond funds; and provides for payment.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Funding was approved in the 1999 and 2003 Park Bond Issues and 2002 Certificates of Obligation for improvements to Woodlawn Lake Park located at 1103 Cincinnati in City Council District 7. The community and the Woodlawn Lake Planning Team provided input on the improvements to the park and were very involved in the determination of the final scope of work. Renovations to Woodlawn Lake Park gymnasium will include accessibility (ADA) modifications, structural upgrades, new restrooms, HVAC system, interior lighting, asbestos and lead abatement, new glazing, landscaping, parking area and building access. Other park improvements include shoreline restoration, erosion control, irrigation, landscaping, perimeter vehicular control, lighting at the Island House entrance roadway/walking path intersection, reconstruction of the "Y" dock, new park playground, additional restrooms and drinking fountains, appropriate and consistent signage throughout the park, and exercise trail modifications to convert Josephine Tobin Bridge at Woodlawn Avenue to pedestrian use only.

The construction bid was advertised in March and April 2005 in the Commercial Recorder, San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa De San Antonio. Three (3) qualified bids were received and Amstar Construction, Inc., a SBE/MBE/WBE firm, was selected with the base bid of \$1,500,000.00 and with bid alternates 1, 2, and 4 for a total amount of \$1,661,800.00. A standard construction contract will be executed. A summary of the bids is shown on Exhibit 1. The firm has one current project with the Public Works Department for municipal facilities improvements in the amount of \$1.7 million and a Parks and Recreation Department park project in the amount of \$829,000.00.

The contract is for 300 calendar days and work is anticipated to begin in July 2005 (after July 4th celebration) and to be completed by May 2006.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The project is identified in the adopted Woodlawn Lake Park Master Plan and will ensure compliance with Federal and State requirements for ADA access. This ordinance will provide for completion of the Woodlawn Lake Park improvements, as approved by the 1999 and 2003 Park Bond Issues. The construction contract was advertised and selected in accordance with established bid procedures.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funds of \$500,000.00 in 1999-2004 Park Bond funds, \$500,000.00 in 2002 Certificates of Obligation, and \$1,015,000.00 in 2003-2007 Park Bond funds have been approved for improvements to Woodlawn Lake Park. The amount of \$229,518.36 has previously been encumbered for design work. This ordinance will appropriate \$1,661,800.00 for the construction contract, \$122,081.64 for construction contingency, and \$1,600.00 for bid advertising and printing fees, for a total amount of \$1,785,481.64. There will be on-going maintenance, operation, and security costs of \$4,025.00 per year associated with the park improvements, which were identified and budgeted within the Department's current General Fund budget.

COORDINATION

This action has been coordinated with the Woodlawn Lake Planning Team, Historical Design Review Commission, the Public Works Department, the Planning Department, the Finance Department, and the Office of Management and Budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

A Discretionary Contract Disclosure statement is not required.



The undersigned, as Bidder, declares that the only person or parties interested in this bid as principals are those named herein; that this bid is made without collusion with any other person, firm, corporation; that Bidder has carefully examined the Project Manual and plans therein referred to, and has carefully examined the requirements of the proposed work; and agrees that the Bidder will provide all the necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction, and will do all the work and furnish all the materials called for in the Project Manual and plans in the manner prescribed therein and according to the requirements of the Director of Public Works as therein set forth.

It is understood and agreed that the work is to be completed in full on or before <u>Three Hundred</u> (300) calendar days.

Accompanying this Bid is a Bid Guaranty in the amount of <u>five Percent (5%)</u> percent of the greatest total amount of the Bid. Said Bid Guaranty, in the form of a Certified or Cashier's Check on a State of National Bank, or Bid Bond, is submitted as a guaranty of the good faith of the Bidder and that the Bidder will execute and enter into a written contract to do the work, if his bid is accepted. The Bidder by submitting this completed form hereby agrees that if he/she fails to execute the written contract and furnish satisfactory bond, within ten (10) calendar days after City Council award, the City of San Antonio shall, in any of such events, be entitled and is hereby given the right to retain said Bid Guaranty as liquidated damages. It is understood that the City of San Antonio reserves the right to reject any and all proposals whenever the City Council deems it in the interest of the City to do so, and also the right to waive any informalities in a bid.

In the event of the award of a contract to the undersigned, the undersigned will execute same on Construction Contract (General Form) and make bond for the full amount of the contract, to secure proper compliance with the terms and provisions of the contract, and to insure and guarantee the work until final completion and acceptance or the end of the guarantee period where so stipulated, and to guarantee payment of all lawful claims for labor performed and materials furnished in the fulfillment of the contract.

The work proposed to be done shall be accepted when fully completed and finished to the entire satisfaction of the Director of Public Works. The undersigned certifies all prices contained in this bid have been carefully checked and are submitted as correct and final.
