SUBJECT: Ordinance approving appointments to the Alamo WorkSource Board
DATE: August 18, 2005

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance approves two appointments to the Alamo WorkSource Board (AWB). The Committee of Six, at its August 2 meeting, recommended the following appointments: Toni Marie Van Buren to fill an un-expired term in the *community based organization* category and Guadalupe Ruvalcaba to fill an un-expired term in the *adult basic and continuing education* category.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Pursuant to the Partnership Agreement between the principal entities and the AWDB, appointees are nominated by the Chief Elected Officials (CEO's) of the Alamo region through their representatives on the "Committee of Six." The Committee is composed of two elected officials each from the City, Bexar County and the surrounding rural area. Currently sitting on the Committee of Six for the City are Mayor Phil Hardberger, Councilman Richard Perez. Councilman Chip Haass serves as alternate. Bexar County Judge Nelson W. Wolff and Commissioner Tommy Atkisson represent Bexar County. Bandera County Judge Richard A. Evans and Comal County Commissioner Jay P. Millikin represent the rural area. The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) stipulates 51 percent of the board must be private sector representatives. There are nine required categories that include organized labor, education, public employment, and vocational rehabilitation among others. The agency also requires local workforce boards to be balanced geographically to represent the entire 12 county region, by ethnicity and by gender.

At its most recent meeting, the Committee of Six chose Toni Marie Van Buren, Director, Public Policy, United Way of San Antonio and Bexar County, to fill the *community based organization* vacancy and Guadalupe Ruvalcaba, Director, Adult and Community Education, San Antonio Independent School District, to serve as the *adult basic and continuing education* representative.

POLICY ANALYSIS


This ordinance is a continuation of current City policy authorizing the City Council to review and approve appointments to the AWB through the Interlocal Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials and the Alamo Workforce Development Inc. The Rural Area Judges, Bexar County Commissioners Court, as well as the San Antonio City Council, must each approve these appointments. These appointments were scheduled for approval by the Area Rural Judges on August 24, 2005 and by the Bexar County Commissioners Court on August 16, 2005.

FISCAL IMPACT


There is no fiscal implication from the approval of these nominations.

COORDINATION




