SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance amends a professional service contract in the amount of \$355,775 payable to Ford Engineering, Inc. for professional engineering services and the obtainment of applicable permitting from TxDOT, authorizes \$35,577.50 for Engineering Contingency, authorizes \$27,394.68 for Capital Administrative Costs, and \$1,500 for Environmental Contingency for a total ordinance amount of \$420,247.18 in connection with the W.W. White Area Outfall, Phase I, Part 1 project, an authorized 2005 Storm Water Revenue Bond project located in Council District 2.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project includes upgrading/constructing a drainage system along Diana Rd. from Rigsby Rd. to Glenoak Drive, street and drainage improvements on Holmgreen from W.W. White to the dead-end, and street and drainage improvements on Glenoak Drive from W.W. White Rd. to Semlinger Rd.

This ordinance provides additional compensation to Ford Engineering, Inc. for engineering services to include feasibility studies, surveying, design, cost estimates, preparation of plans and bid documents, and bid and construction phase services. Ford Engineering, Inc. will also provide additional services that include, but are not limited to, Texas Department of Licensing and Regulations (TDLR) review and inspection, preparation of a traffic control plan, and permitting. This professional services contract was originally approved through City Ordinance No. 81871 on March 16, 1995 and initially authorized \$84,000.00 for services related to the W.W. White Rd. Phase I from Rigsby to Lord Rd. project, which also included design services for the W.W. White Rd. Area Streets project. The W.W. White Rd. Area Streets project encompassed several of the streets listed in this project. Subsequent City Council action has increased the contract amount to \$498,726.64. This Council action will increase the total authorized for this professional service contract to \$854,501.64.

By amending this contract, Public Works will be able to save an estimated \$225,000 on design fees, as well as be able to reduce the amount of time needed to design this project by nine months. The majority of this project has been completed through Final Design and will only require updating to current conditions and codes. This will also result in lower construction costs associated with inflation by awarding the project nine months earlier.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 2005 Storm Water Revenue Bond Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY 05-10 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$420,247.18 are available from 2005 Storm Water Revenue Bond funds and are authorized payable as follows:

\$355,775.00	to Ford Engineering, Inc. for engineering services
\$ 35,577.50	for Engineering Contingency
\$ 27,394.68	for Capital Administrative Costs
\$ 1,500.00	for Environmental Contingency




