SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the single source bid submitted by Andela Products, Ltd. to provide the City of San Antonio Environmental Services Department with glass pulverizer parts and accessories for a total of \$82,546.00, from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality 2005 Regional Solid Waste Pass-Through Grants as administered through the Alamo Area Council of Governments. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Submitted for Council consideration and action is an ordinance accepting the sole source bid from Andela Products, Ltd. to provide the City of San Antonio Environmental Services Department with replacement parts and additional components designed to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the current glass pulverizer system.

In August 2001, per Ordinance No. 94365, the City of San Antonio Environmental Services Department received AACOG grant funding to purchase a GP-07 Model glass pulverizer system. The pulverizer system is designed for the size reduction, processing and recycling of all types of glass and ceramic materials to varying grades of aggregate from 3/8" to fine sand. The department has many practical uses for the pulverized glass to include landscaping, road construction and walking and jogging trails.

This pulverizer is solely manufactured by Andela Products, Ltd and they are also the only vendor that can provide the replacement parts, accessories and components required to continue efficient and effective operation of the current system.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The Environmental Services Department has the responsibility of promoting various recycling programs and encourages citizens to recycle items such as glass and aluminum. This contract will provide the Environmental Services Department with electronic control system upgrade, replacement parts and additional components for the existing glass pulverizer system. The new components are designed to be added to the existing equipment to form a single operating unit.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of the contract is \$82,546.00. Funding will be from the TCEQ FY2005 Regional Solid Waste Pass-Through Grants as administered through the Alamo Area Council of Governments. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY 2004-2005 Budget approved by City Council.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with the City of San Antonio Environmental Services Department.
