This zoning change would serve as a continuation of the residential development to the west. Staff is recommending approval of this case because access to the property from the west is currently under construction.

Applicant: Salah E. Diab

Zoning Request: "C-2" Commercial District to "R-3" Residential Single Family District.

Salah E. Diab, representing the owner, stated is part of the approved master development plan, Highland Heights Subdivision. He stated the purpose of this zoning change is to develop garden homes on the subject property. He further stated the maximum units are 48 but they are proposing to develop 44 to 45 units.

<u>Jim Meyers</u>, 5539 Cool Valley, President of People Active in Community Efforts (PACE), stated they have met with Mr. Diab to discuss his proposal and he would like to express their support for this project. He stated they strongly support residential development into the community.

Staff stated there were 4 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 0 returned in opposition and 2 returned in favor and People Active in Community Effort is in favor.
