SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with Franklin Elementary Fall Costume March being held on Monday, October 31, 2005. The walk will assemble and disband at 1915 W. Olmos. The route is attached.

POLICY ANALYSIS
