**SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with Say No to Drugs Walk Red Ribbon Week for Saturday, October 28, 2005. The walk will assemble and disband at 7320 Remuda (Mary Hull Elementary). The route is attached.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

**POLICY ANALYSIS**

This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The City will receive revenues of \$25 from this event and there will be no additional costs incurred. All insurance requirements, public safety devices (signs, barricades) and any off-duty police as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department shall be the responsibility of the event sponsor, Mary Hull Elementary.

**COORDINATION**


This event has been coordinated with the City Manager's Office, the Traffic Section of the Police Department, and the Traffic Division of the Public Works Department. All of the involved city departments concur with the staff recommendation to approve this request.



I have attached a copy of the parade permit to assist you with the street closure ordinance.


