SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the 2005 Veteran's Parade being held on Saturday, November 5, 2005. The parade will assemble at Avenue E between Third and Brooklyn and disband at Houston Street between Santa Rosa and San Saba. The route is attached.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City will receive revenues of \$25 from this event and there will be no additional costs incurred. All insurance requirements, public safety devices (signs, barricades) and any off-duty police as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department shall be the responsibility of the event sponsor, U. S. Military Veteran's Parade Association.

COORDINATION




