


Staff Recommendation:

The 20-foot increase would allow for the tower to be used by multiple carriers as opposed to building a new tower. This extension would be appropriate in this area due to the lack of residential development within 200 feet of the property and the potential to allow for multiple carriers to use the same tower.

<u>Brock Bailey</u>, 500 N. Akard, representing Verizon Wireless, stated they are proposing to extend an existing telecommunications tower currently 99 feet tall by 20 feet.

Staff stated there were 5 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 0 returned in opposition and 0 returned in favor and 3 received in opposition outside the 200-foot radius. Vance Jackson Neighborhood Association is in opposition and no response from Wellsprings Home Owners Association.

Everyone present, for and against having been heard and the results of the written notices having been received, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.
