

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This is the first of two statutory public hearings regarding the proposed creation of the Defense Adjustment Management Authority.

No action is required of the Council at this public hearing.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

One of the goals of the City is to balance San Antonio's growth by attracting new residents and businesses by promoting sustainable development and economic growth in an area rich with environmental, historical, human and economic resources. One method to achieve that goal is to create a Defense Adjustment Management Authority (DAMA) in the area known as City South.

As part of the Public Hearing, staff will provide an overview of the DAMA creation process. Specifically, the following items will be discussed:
