SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the bid submitted by Fisher Scientific Company, L.L.C. utilizing the Houston Galveston Council of Governments contract (HGAC) to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with software and accessories that will be used to track equipment and personnel on the ground at the scene of an incident for a total of \$33,265.00 from the 2004 Assistance to Firefighter Act Grant fund. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City of San Antonio Fire Department was issued grant money from the 2004 Assistance to Firefighter Act Grant. These funds will provide the funding for the purchase of software licenses, training, equipment and maintenance for Asset Trax and field licenses for Fire Trax Command software. This purchase will provide the Fire Department with tracking and identification abilities for equipment and personnel located at the scene of an incident. This purchase will supplement current software and equipment utilized by the Fire Department and the Emergency Operations Center previously purchased with grant funds last year. The system is also needed to satisfy requirements of the 2004 Assistance to Firefighter Act Grant, which provides for the safety and accountability of fire fighters on the fire-ground. While the overall system may provide tracking functionality for other departments such as Police, Public Works, Metropolitan Health District or other Emergency Management personnel as needed, this portion of the system deals primarily with fire-ground accountability. It meets the objectives of the 2004 Assistance to Firefighters Grant submittal that states that the Department will "Install accountability software in 100% of department command vehicles (10) within 8 months of grant funding." This equipment will improve personnel and equipment tracking at incident scenes, which can minimize fire-ground injuries, thus decreasing line of duty and overtime charges that can negatively impact budget.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This contract will provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with software licenses, equipment and software maintenance utilizing grant funds made available from the 2004 Assistance to Firefighter Act Grant.

This purchase will be made from Fisher Scientific Company, L.L.C. utilizing the HGAC contract in accordance with the Houston Galveston Cooperative Purchasing Program passed on resolution no. 96-41-48.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this contract is \$33,265.00. Funding will be from the Grants in Aid Trust Fund -2004 Assistance to Firefighter Act Grant. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 Budget approved by City Council.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with the City of San Antonio Fire Department and the Information Technology Services Department.
