SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the low bid submitted by Med-Eng Systems to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with bomb suits and helmets for a total of \$35,460.00 from the State Homeland Security Grant funds. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A request for sealed bids was issued for bomb suits and helmets for the City of San Antonio Police Department. A total of three bids were received. The low bid was submitted by Med-Eng Systems for a total of \$35,460.00. This bid was advertised in the Daily Commercial Recorder, La Prensa, the City of San Antonio Purchasing Website, Public Access Channel 21 and Demandstar.com.

This contract will provide one medium sized and one large sized replacement bomb suit and two bomb helmets for the City of San Antonio Police Department Bomb Squad Division. These items will be used by the Bomb Squad Technicians to provide protection during the identification and disposal of hazardous unexploded devices. Currently, there are two older model bomb suits and helmets in their inventory which were purchased five years ago. These two new bomb suits and helmets will replace the older bomb suits. The older model bomb suits will be kept in reserve in case of a situation that would require additional suits.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The Police Department Bomb Squad Unit is responsible for identifying, rendering safely and disposing of hazardous unexploded devices. These suits will provide the protection required during incidents involving bomb threats and unidentified devices. Additionally, the new bomb suits and helmets are estimated to last at least five years.

In 2004, the City of San Antonio, Bexar County and County received an Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security used to address the unique needs of high threat and high density urban areas.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this contract is \$35,460.00. Funding will be from the Grants in Aid Trust Fund - Urban Area Security Initiative Fund. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 Budget approved by City Council.

This item has been coordinated with the City of San Antonio Police Departments.
