SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the bid submitted by One Stop Services, Inc., an MBE company, to provide the City of San Antonio Aviation Department with carpet removal and installation at the San Antonio International Airport for a total of \$72,490.60 from the Airport Improvement and Contingency fund. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A request for sealed bids was issued for carpet removal and installation to include labor, materials and equipment for the City of San Antonio Aviation Department International Airport. A total of three bids were received. The low bid was submitted by One Stop Services, Inc., an MBE company, for a total of \$72,490.60. This bid was advertised in the Daily Commercial Recorder, La Prensa, the City of San Antonio Purchasing Website, Public Access Channel 21 and Demandstar.com.

This contract will provide labor, materials and equipment to remove and replace the carpeting in the Terminal One jet bridges and north concourse of the San Antonio International Airport. This terminal has two concourses and sixteen boarding gates with a passenger travel rate of 2,307,462 enplanements for fiscal year 2004. Both concourses and jet bridges are carpeted with the north concourse bearing the majority of passenger travel. The existing carpet is at the end of its useful life and is in permanently worn and soiled condition. Therefore, it is necessary to install new carpeting at the Airport to maintain safe walkways.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The City of San Antonio Aviation Department operates a first class International Airport. The airport was visited by 3,498,972 enplaned passengers from all over the world in fiscal year ending 2004. This contract will provide labor, materials and equipment for the installation of new carpeting in Terminal One. The carpet procured through this contract will last approximately three to four years.

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FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of this contract is \$72,490.60. Funding will be from the Airport Improvement and Contingency Fund. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 Budget approved by City Council.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with the City of San Antonio Aviation Department.
