SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the acceptance of a Gift Deed from the Methodist Healthcare Systems of San Antonio, Ltd., a Texas limited liability partnership, for a right of way dedication consisting of a 0.0078 acre tract of land out of Lot 30, New City Block 12830, within the San Antonio Medical Foundation Subdivision Unit-1, located in Council District 8.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Due to increasing population and development in the Medical Center Area, the City and the Medical Center Alliance, a group comprised of most major medical facilities in the Medical Center area, entered into a development agreement in June 2004. Under this agreement each party would fund a portion of intersection improvements in order to reduce traffic congestion in the Medical Center area.

The boundaries of the Medical Center are Fredericksburg Road to the north, Babcock Road to the south, Hamilton Wolfe Road to the east, and Louis Pasteur Drive to the west.

The Methodist Healthcare Systems of San Antonio, Ltd., as part of the Medical Center Alliance, desires to dedicate a 0.0078 acre (or 339 square feet, more or less) tract of land out of Lot 30, New City Block 12830 of the portion of San Antonio Medical Foundation Subdivision Unit 1, San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas. This parcel is necessary to complete improvements at the intersection of Floyd Curl Drive and Wurzbach Road.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to enter into public/private partnerships for infrastructure improvements in order to leverage funds and resources.

FISCAL IMPACT

No funds are to be expended under this ordinance.

COORDINATION

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office and the Office of Management and Budget.

AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING TITLE TO A PARCEL OF LAND FROM THE METHODIST HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS OF SAN ANTONIO, LTD., L.L.P, SUCH LAND CONSISTING OF A 0.0078 ACRE OR 338 SQUARE FEET MORE OR LESS TRACT OF LAND OUT OF LOT 30, NEW CITY BLOCK 12830 OF THE PORTION OF SAN ANTONIO MEDICAL FOUNDATION SUBDIVISION UNIT 1, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, DONATED IN CONNECTION WITH THE MEDICAL CENTER INERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PHASE II PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City of San Antonio hereby accepts title to one parcel of real property from Methodist Healthcare Systems of San Antonio, Ltd., L.L.P., said property being a 0.0078 acre or 339 square feet, more or less, tract of land out of Lot 30, New City Block 12830 of the portion of San Antonio Medical Foundation Subdivision Unit 1 as recorded in Volume 7100, Page 86 of the Deed and Plat Records of Bexar County, Texas, and more particularly described by metes and bounds as shown on **Attachment I** attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee is authorized to perform any administrative tasks necessary for the completion of such transfer.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on the ______ day of ______ 2005.




