SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance approves Field Alteration Number 3 in the amount of \$32,867.30 payable to KGME, Inc., in connection with the Lanark Drainage project #92A, Phase I Project, an authorized 1999-2004 General Obligation Drainage Improvement Bond funded project, located in Council District 2.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project consists of channel improvements along Walzem Creek from Lanark to Overland, as well as reconstruction of Dell Oak, Overland, and a portion of Ashland to eliminate low water crossings at the intersection of said channel and streets. The street construction includes street widths of 30-feet with curbs, sidewalks, wheelchair ramps, and required retaining walls. Construction is ongoing and is scheduled to be completed by February of 2006.

This ordinance authorizes Field Alteration Number 3, in the amount of \$32,867.30 to compensate for the additional cost of drilling five thirty-inch diameter drill shafts for the new bridges being constructed at Dell Oak and Overland with a special rig due to low clearances from high voltage electrical power lines. Field Alteration Number 3 is incorporated herein as Attachment 2.

A previously executed contract with KGME, Inc. for the Lanark Drainage Project #92A, Phase I project in the amount of \$2,934,279.61 was approved by City Council on May 20, 2004 through Ordinance No. 99200. Subsequent field alterations have increased the contract amount to \$2,984,866.54. This field alteration will increase the total contract amount to \$3,017,733.84.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 1999-2004 General Obligation Drainage Improvement Bond funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and is not included in the FY 06-11 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$32,867.30 are available from the previously authorized project contingency.

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.


