#### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid, appropriates funds, and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$1,627,973.43 payable to San Antonio Constructors, Inc., (SBE) authorizes \$124,428.02 for Project Contingency, authorizes \$95,809.57 for Capital Administration Cost and \$2,000 for Advertising Expenses, for a total ordinance amount of \$1,850,211.02 in connection with the Culebra Area Streets Phase IV Project, an authorized 2003-2007 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond funded project located in Council District 7. Of the \$1,850,211.02 amount \$1,466,517.74 will be funded with City Funds and \$383,693.28 will be reimbursed by San Antonio Water System (SAWS).

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project provides for the reconstruction of Broadview from Pettus to Hemphill and Pettus from Culebra to Broadview to include curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches and necessary drainage. Project construction is anticipated to begin in January 2006 and to be completed by November 2006.

This project was advertised for construction bids in the <u>Commercial Recorder</u>, the <u>San Antonio Informer</u>, and <u>La Prensa</u> in September of 2005. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders at the office of HDR Engineering, Inc., 1100 NE Loop 410 San Antonio, Texas 78209-1520. Bids for this project were opened on October 5, 2005, and five (5) firms responded. Of these, San Antonio Constructors, Ltd., submitted the lowest responsive bid. San Antonio Constructors, Ltd., currently has two (2) active contracts with the City in the amount of \$1,083,000, and one Indefinite Delivery Contract in an amount not to exceed \$3,999,999. A matrix of the bid outcome is included herein as Attachment 2 and the construction contract is included herein as Attachment 3.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by San Antonio Constructors, Ltd., and the contractor has committed that 34.76% of the work provided under this contract shall be completed by a MBE and .344% will be completed by an AABE firm. The Memorandum from the Economic Development Department is included herein as Attachment 4.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete 2003-2007 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond funded projects.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure. Funds in the amount of \$1,319,000 are included in the FY06-11 Capital Improvement Program Budget. A portion of this item in the amount of \$147,517.74 is not within budget, but funds are available from Community Development Block Grants from the Culebra Area Streets Phase III project. Funds in the amount of \$1,019,000 are available from 2003-2007 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond funds, \$447,517.74 is available from Community Development Block Grant funds, and \$383,693.28 is available from SAWS funds and authorized payable and appropriated as follows:


This construction contract was developed utilizing the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.

This project is funded with 2003 Street Bond Funds.

#### Recommendation:

The lowest bid was from San Antonio Constructors, Inc. listed as \$1,627,973.43, and the city will award San Antonio Constructors, Inc., whose bid included the Base Bid, SAWS sewer work and SAWS water work totaling \$1,627,973.43.

These categories were set up as the basis for bidder selection. It is recommended that the project scope consist of the following three categories: Base Bid, SAWS sewer work and SAWS water work totaling \$1,627,973.43. A copy of the recommendation letter from the Consultant is attached. It is further recommended that a construction contingency in the amount of \$124,428.02 be established, that a Construction advertisement fund in the amount of \$2,000.00 be established and a Capital Administrative Cost of \$87,099.61.
