SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid, appropriates funds, and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$596,310.00 payable to Bentley Sheet Metal & Roofing Co., Inc., and authorizes \$59,631.00 for Project Contingency \$45,915.87 for Capital Administrative Costs and \$2,000.00 for Advertising Expenses, and approves Field Alteration No. 1, deducting \$148,620.00 for architectural modifications, for a total ordinance amount of \$555,236.87 in connection with the re-roofing of the Bob Ross Multi-Service Health and Resource Center project, an authorized HUD 108 Loan funded project, located at 2219 Babcock in the Medical Center Area in Council District 8, which is a collaborative effort between Bexar County and the City.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The first phase of this project includes re-roofing the existing flat roof in its entirety. The built-up ballast roof is near the end of its life cycle and shows significant signs of deterioration. Additionally, all gutters will be replaced. This project is scheduled to begin construction in February of 2006 and to be completed by May of 2006.

This project was advertised for construction bids in the <u>Commercial Recorder</u>, the <u>San Antonio Informer</u>, and <u>La Prensa</u> in October of 2005. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Office and the Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders at the office of Chesney, Morales & Associates, Inc., located at 4901 Broadway, Suite 250, San Antonio, Texas 78209. Bids for this project were opened on November 30, 2005 and two (2) firms responded. Of these Bentley Sheet Metal & Roofing Co., Inc., submitted the lowest responsive bid. Bentley Sheet Metal & Roofing Co., Inc. currently has no active contracts with the City. A matrix of the bid outcome is included herein as Attachment 2.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by Bentley Sheet Metal & Roofing Co. and the contractor has committed that none of the work to be provided under this contract shall be completed by a MBE firm, WBE's or AABE's. The Memorandum from the Economic Development Department is included herein as Attachment 3.

This ordinance also authorizes Field Alteration Number 1, in the deductive amount of \$148,620.00 for architectural modifications that include the deletion of the proposed HVAC system that were part of the original construction documents. Field Alteration Number 1 is incorporated herein as Attachment 4.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to participate in the development and construction of HUD 108 Loan funded project.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY 06-11 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$376,000.00 are available from Community and Development Block Grant funds and \$179,506.87 are available from HUD 108 Loan funded project funds. Funds are authorized to be appropriated and payable as follows:

\$ 447,690.00	payable to Bentley Sheet Metal & Roofing Co., Inc. for construction services
\$ 59,631.00	for Project Contingency
\$ 45,915.87	for Capital Administrative Costs
\$ 2,000.00	for Advertising Expenses

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Finance Department, the Office of Management and Budget, the Community Initiatives Department, the Health Department and Bexar County.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

This construction contract was developed utilizing the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.


