SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance will grant a license to use Public Rights of Way on, over and under East Crockett and Losoya Streets for numerous encroachments at the adjacent newly redeveloped Rainforest Café at 110 East Crockett Street in NCB 914 in Council District No.1, for a 25-year term and the consideration of \$52,792.50.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Petitioner is requesting a license to use East Crockett and Losoya Streets Public Rights of Way adjacent to NCB 914 as shown on attached Exhibit "A." Petitioner plans to develop the property at 110 East Crockett Street and open the Rainforest Café. Development plans entail numerous encroachments on, over and under the Rights of Way; which are listed and detailed on attached Exhibit "B", Pages 1 throught 5. The petitioner is working directly with the Parks and Recreation Department to lease the space over the Riverwalk for new signage, a ramp, a patio and fence with lighting as well as the tables and chairs within the patio, and an existing tenant landing.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with the City Code and Ordinances which require City Council approval for any private use of property owned or controlled by the City.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City will collect \$52,792.50 for this license to use Public Right of Way.

COORDINATION

In compliance with City procedures, this request has been canvassed through interested City departments, public utilities and applicable agencies. A Canvassing Checklist and an executed Letter of Agreement, by which the petitioner agrees with all conditions imposed through this canvassing, are attached for review.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

The City of San Antonio's Planning Commission recommended approval of this request at its regular meeting of 1/11/2006.








View of northeast corner of subject property






RAINFOREST CAFE - SAN ANTONIO ASSESSMENT SUBMITTAL


FIRST LEVEL (STREET LEVEL)

With reference to the captioned project, please be advised that the City of San Antonio has now completed the canvassing process and will recommend approval of your request subject to the following conditions:

PLANNING DEPARTMENT

Approved provided new sidewalks match existing sidewalks.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Approved provided that the proposed construction of the ramp and landing on the north side (Crockett St.) of the building meet City of San Antonio (COSA) accessibility manual requirements and American Disabilities Act (ADA) standards; the proposed signs that are to be placed below existing balconies must allow for pedestrian protected zone as per ADA standards; and patio improvements must meet COSA accessibility requirements and ADA standards.

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT

Approved provided all sidewalk modifications comply with COSA and ADA standards; and new sidewalk lighting is compatible with existing streetlights.

SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM

Approved provided perpetual easements are reserved for all existing water and/or sewer facilities and petitioners must allow access to any such utilities for inspection, operational and maintenance purposes.

The fee established for this license agreement is \$52,792.50 for a 25-year term. The City of San Antonio must be formally released from any and all liabilities, which may be incurred in connection with this request, and a Certificate of Insurance must be provided along with a fully completed and signed Discretionary Contracts Disclosure form which is enclosed for your convenience.

If you concur with the above mentioned conditions, please countersign this letter in the space provided below and return to the undersigned. Upon receipt of this signed Letter of Agreement, the License Agreement, the Certificate of Insurance, the Discretionary Contracts Disclosure form and the fee we will continue processing your request.

This Letter of Agreement is being offered by the City of San Antonio only to the above named petitioner and will expire thirty (30) days after the date of issuance unless a specific extension is requested by the petitioner and granted by the City.
