SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept and execute a contract totaling \$353,133.00 from the Texas Department of State Health Services (TDSHS) to renew support for the ongoing Tuberculosis (TB) Prevention and Control Program in the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006. This ordinance also adopts the program budget, approves the personnel complement and authorizes payments for contractual services.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

TDSHS provides annual assistance to the City to support core public health activities provided by the SAMHD. TDSHS has issued Public Health State Support Project 2006/2007 Contract 7460020708 2007 and will issue contract changes throughout the term of the contract in order to renew grant programs when their terms expire. Attachment No. 01 included in this contract renews support for the ongoing Tuberculosis (TB) Prevention and Control Program in the SAMHD. The TB Program investigates, diagnoses and manages suspected cases of tuberculosis as well as confirmed cases. The TB Clinic has over 6,500 patient visits and the TB outreach staff make over 11,500 patient home visits each year. The TB outreach staff administer TB medications to patients at home, work, and school, and observe patients to ensure compliance with physicians' orders as required by law. Non-compliant patients with confirmed cases of TB disease are issued a court order for quarantine. In addition staff conducts TB disease investigations, and individual and group educational programs on tuberculosis disease prevention. TB services are available to residents and visitors of Bexar County.

The TDSHS funding for this program is \$3,567.00 less than last year's funding of \$356,700.00. The program has been reorganized to upgrade the skill level of the nursing and administration staff and to eliminate vacant and unused positions. This has resulted in a consolidation of the staff personnel complement from fourteen to seven positions.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Acceptance of this grant from TDSHS will continue the long-standing practice of utilizing Federal and State aid to support the local public health programs of the City.

FISCAL IMPACT

This TDSHS grant contract provides \$353,133.00 to renew support for the TB Prevention and Control Program in the SAMHD. In addition, the activity will receive approximately \$22,500.00 from patient co-payments, bringing the total budget of the program to \$375,633.00.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office and the Human Resources Department, Risk Management Division have reviewed the contract with TDSHS. The Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department have been apprised of the program budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.
