#### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance will grant a license to use Public Right of Way over East Houston and East Craig Place for an existing stone facing, cap and stone columns with an iron grille at the adjacent Keystone School at 119 East Craig Place in NCB 1706 in Council District No.1, for a 10-year term and the consideration of \$5,000.00.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Petitioner is requesting a license agreement renewal for the continued use of Public Right of Way over East Craig Place for an existing stone facing, cap and stone columns with an iron grille at the adjacent 119 East Craig Place in NCB 1706 as shown on attached Exhibit "A." This use was previously licensed under Ordinance No. 52875 and approved by City Council on October 9, 1980.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

This action is consistent with the City Code and Ordinances which require City Council approval for any private use of property owned or controlled by the City.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The City will collect \$5,000.00 for this license to use Public Right of Way.


