SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the purchase of Aircraft Hull and Liability Insurance on the Cityowned helicopters operated by the San Antonio Police department, with ACE Property and Casualty Insurance Company, through McGriff, Seibels & Williams of Texas, Inc., the City's Broker of Record. The policy coverage is for a one (1) year period beginning March 31, 2006 through March 31, 2007 for an annual premium not to exceed \$209,403.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City advertised a Request for Insurance Quotes in the San Antonio Express News/on February 5, 2006 and February 12, 2006, which solicited for Aircraft Hull and Liability Insurance. The City's Broker of Record also began marketing activities for this renewal coverage in January 2006 and approached ten insurance markets. Eight companies declined to quote and one was considered non-responsive. One quote was received from ACE Property and Casualty Insurance Company, our current insurer for this coverage.

The premium quote from ACE Property and Casualty Insurance Company provides for physical damage and liability coverage. Third party claims arising from the operation of the City's helicopters is also included in the policy with a single limit for both bodily injury and property damage of \$10,000,000 per occurrence. A sublimit of \$5,000 per person per seat in each aircraft is provided for medical payments to passengers and crew members.

The deductibles under the proposed coverage differ depending upon whether the rotors are engaged (in motion), in flight, or not in motion or in flight. A \$500 deductible applies if the helicopter hull is not in flight and also not in motion. For accidents occurring while in motion or in flight, the deductable equates to 5% of the aircraft's insured value.

Additional coverages in the ACE Property and Casualty Insurance Company's proposal include cargo legal liability up to \$150,000 and \$300,000 coverage for spare parts and extra expense. Non-owned Aircraft Liability coverage, subject to specific terms and conditions, is also included. The "FLIR" Equipment (Forward Looking Infra Red System) is insured up to \$250,000 with a \$500 per-occurrence deductible if the loss occurs when the aircraft is not in motion and \$5,000 per-occurrence deductible if the aircraft is in motion.

Last year the City spent \$164,430 in premiums for insuring three helicopters. Prior to last year's policy renewal, on January 18, 2005, a 1997 N296RL helicopter was involved in a training exercise involving hovering maneuvers. An accident resulted from this training exercise and the craft was damaged beyond repair. The amount recovered from this loss was \$522,936. On February 19, 2004, the City sustained another total loss to an aircraft, due to a hard landing after complete engine failure. The insurer paid \$864,158 for the replacement aircraft plus equipment, which the City acquired on December 30, 2004.

The Police Department is considering the purchase of two additional helicopters within this policy period. When the City takes possession of these aircrafts, they will be added to this policy for a pro-rata premium through the end of the policy term.

McGriff, Seibels & Williams of Texas, Inc., the City's Broker of Record, recommends placing the City's Aircraft Hull and Liability insurance coverage with ACE Property and Casualty Insurance Company for the next renewal year. The annual premium cost for the three (3) insured helicopters is \$164,430 which is the same compared to last year. The premium for the two additional helicopters is estimated at \$44,973, for a total annual premium not to exceed \$209,403 for all 5 aircraft.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is in keeping with the City's past practice of purchasing Aircraft Hull and Liability Insurance to provide coverage for City-owned helicopters operated by the San Antonio Police Department. The Risk Management Division concurs with McGriff, Seibels, & Williams of Texas' recommendation.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Sufficient funds have been budgeted in the Liability Self-Insurance Fund for the purchase of this insurance policy.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with Finance, San Antonio Police Department, Office of Management and Budget, and the City Attorney's Office.
