#### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes payment of a judgment in the above lawsuit in the approximate amount of \$238,208.61. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

On September 6, 1999, Plaintiffs' vehicle was struck by City driver, Rolando Lopez., while turning at an intersection. Claudio Esparza, Jr. and Minerva Esparza suffered injuries and filed suit. Both the City and Plaintiffs attended mediation but a settlement agreement was not reached. On May 13, 2004, a jury ruled in favor of Plaintiffs in an amount of \$220,675.00. On December 21, 2005, the 4th Court of Appeals lowered the original award to \$203,748.71. Plaintiffs are entitled to pre and post-judgment interest. This lawsuit will be discussed with City Council in executive session on March 23, 2006.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

If approved, payments will be made from the City's Liability Self Insurance Fund to Claudio Esparza, Jr., Minerva Esparza, and their attorneys, Gonzalez & Gonzalez, L.L.P. in the judgment amount plus pre and post-judgment interest, which accrues at approximately \$29.00 per day.
