SUBJECT: River Walk Lease Agreement with Rainforest Café, Inc.

DATE: January 5, 2006

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the execution of a standard five (5) year Lease Agreement with Rainforest Café, Inc., a restaurant, for lease of patio space on the San Antonio River Walk in City Council District 1 for outdoor dining purposes.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City owns properties along the San Antonio River Walk, which are leased to businesses through contracts negotiated by the Parks and Recreation Department Contract Services Division. The agreement under consideration is with Rainforest Café, Inc. for an area containing a total of approximately 196 square feet of public property on the River Walk for outside dining purposes. This is a new lease for this business.

The lease is for a five (5) year term from January 15, 2006 through January 14, 2011. The agreement specifies a rent of \$1.77 per square foot per month for the first year (\$4,163.04, annually), increasing each year by a rate of two and one-half percent. This rate is consistent for this area of the River Walk.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This lease agreement is consistent with other leases presently in effect for space on the San Antonio River Walk. It continues the City's policy to enter into agreements that provide good quality entertainment and restaurant services for visitors to this important City Parks and Recreation Department facility.

FISCAL IMPACT

The monthly rental is \$1.77 per square foot per month for the first lease year and will increase by a rate of two and one-half percent (2.5%) per square foot per year, commencing on the anniversary date of each remaining lease year. The City will receive the following rental income from this proposed Lease Agreement:

First 12 months	(\$1.77 per square foot per month):	\$346.92/monthly	\$4,163.04/annually
Second 12 months	(\$1.81 per square foot per month):	\$354.76/monthly	\$4,257.12/annually
Third 12 months	(\$1.86 per square foot per month):	\$364.56/monthly	\$4,374.72/annually
Fourth 12 months	(\$1.91 per square foot per month):	\$374.36/monthly	\$4,492.32/annually
Fifth 12 months	(\$1.95 per square foot per month):	\$382.20/monthly	\$4,586.40/annually

These rental fees will be deposited into the River Walk Capital Improvement Fund.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office, Risk Management Office, Asset Management Department, Finance Department and Office of Management and Budget have reviewed this item.


