SUBJECT: Truck Mounted Thermoplastic Pavement Marker

SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the low responsive bid submitted by Rush Truck Center - Houston to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with one truck mounted thermoplastic pavement marker for a total of \$297,621.00 from the 2006 Traffic Signal Installation and Upgrade Project. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A request for sealed bids was issued to purchase one truck mounted thermoplastic pavement marker for the City of San Antonio Public Works Department. A total of four bids were received. The bid submitted by Henna Chevrolet, LP, Bid No. 2 did not meet bid specifications. The low responsive bid was submitted by Rush Truck Center - Houston for a total of \$297,621.00. This bid was advertised in the Daily Commercial Recorder, La Prensa, the San Antonio Observer, the City of San Antonio Purchasing Website, Public Access Channel 21 and Demandstar.com.

The new truck mounted thermoplastic pavement marker truck will be utilized for striping roadways and traffic lanes throughout the City. The new unit is an addition to the existing paint striping truck currently in operation and will allow the department to provide more area of coverage and have a back up unit. The ability to add another pavement marker truck will allow City staff to be more productive.

Additionally, the truck mounted thermoplastic pavement marker will be covered by a two-year unlimited parts and labor mileage warranty for the truck and body. The estimated life expectancy of this new truck is 10 years.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This contract will provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department Traffic Division with one truck mounted thermoplastic pavement marker truck. This unit is a one-time purchase that will be part of the City's Vehicle Replacement Program when placed in operation. The pavement marker truck is an important component to Public Works' ability in maintaining cost efficient operations. The successful vendor is required to provide two on-site training sessions for a minimum of eight hours each for City operators and technicians and a video demonstrating the safe operation of the entire system.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total cost of this contract is \$297,621.00. Funding will be from the the 2006 Traffic Signal Installation and Upgrade Project. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 Budget approved by City Council.

COORDINATION

This item has been coordinated with the City of San Antonio Public Works Department.


