**DATE:** April 20, 2006

**SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION**

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the low responsive bids submitted by Texas Equipment Company, a WBE, item 1; and Extendo Bed Company, Inc., items 2 and 3 to provide the City of San Antonio Environmental Services, Fire and Police Departments with 5 mini dump truck bodies and 14 pickup bed slides for a total of \$90,501.00 from the Equipment Renewal and Replacement Fund. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

A request for sealed bids was issued to purchase 5 mini dump trucks and 14 pickup bed slides for the City of San Antonio Environmental Services, Fire and Police Departments. A total of three bids were received. The bid submitted by TVIB, LLC did not meet bid specifications. The low responsive bids were submitted by Texas Equipment Company, a WBE, item 1, for a total of \$37,125.00 and Extendo Bed Company, Inc., items 2 and 3 for a total of \$53,376.00. This bid was advertised in the Daily Commercial Recorder, La Prensa, the San Antonio Observer, the City of San Antonio Purchasing Website, Public Access Channel 21 and Demandstar.com.

This contract will provide various truck bodies to be installed on existing City owned cab and chassis. These units will then become part of the City's Vehicle Replacement Program and will be on a 10 year replacement cycle. This contract includes mini dump bodies and pickup bed slides that will be utilized in a variety of applications.

Five mini dump bodies will be procured for Environmental Services Solid Waste Division. These units will be installed in the bed of existing 2006 Dodge pickup trucks already purchased by the City and in its fleet inventory. The dump bodies, along with the new pickups will be replacing five units currently used by Environmental Services.

Three pickup bed slides (minimum 90 inch steel frame) are new units being purchased for Fire Department's Command Units. The slides are used to organize equipment and air tanks used by the Fire Department. The 90 inch steel frames will be installed in the bed of existing 2006 Ford Crew cab pickup trucks already purchased by the City and in its fleet inventory. The combination of pickups and slides are replacing the current Suburban type vehicles that are being utilized by the department.

Mini Dump Trucks

Eleven pickup bed slides (minimum 72 inch steel frame) are new units being purchased for Police Department Evidence Unit. The slides will be used to organize equipment used by the Evidence Unit. The 72 inch steel frames will be installed in the bed of 2006 Ford short wheel base pickup trucks already purchased by the City and in its fleet inventory. The combination of pickups and slides are replacing the sports utility vehicle types that are being utilized by the department.

All pickup bed slide units are transferable to other pickups when replacement becomes necessary. Furthermore, this configuration will separate the occupants from the equipment which will provide better comfort and safety for the occupants inside of the truck.

This reconfiguration is funded by the Vehicle Replacement Program and will replace the suburban and utility vehicles that were previously used with the combination truck and body units.

**POLICY ANALYSIS**


This contract will provide 5 mini dump trucks and 14 pickup bed slides to be utilized for maintenance and efficiency of solid waste collection, command operations and evidence collection. All equipment being purchased is covered by a one year warranty for parts and labor.


**FINANCIAL IMPACT**


