### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

An ordinance approving Change Order 19 (final) in the amount of \$29,457.98 payable to FMG Constructing Co., L.L.C. and amending the professional architectural services agreement in the amount of \$21,272.60 with Rehler, Vaughn & Koone, Inc. and appropriating a total amount of \$50,730.58, in connection with the Julia Yates Semmes Branch Library project, an authorized 1999 General Obligation Library Systems Improvement Bond project, located in District 10.

Change Order 19 (final) is necessary to reconcile original material quantities versus the actual quantities used upon completion of the project. A previously executed contract with FMG Constructing Co., L.L.C. for the Julia Yates Semmes Branch Library at Comanche Lookout Park in the amount of \$3,220,315.00 was approved by City Council on May 13, 2004, through Ordinance No. 99195. Subsequent Change Orders have increased the contract amount by \$149,464.17. This Change Order will increase the total contract amount to \$3,399,237.15.

This ordinance also amends the professional services agreement with Rehler, Vaughn & Koone, Inc. and provides funds in the amount of \$21,272.60 for additional construction administration fees. A previously executed agreement with Rehler, Vaughn & Koone, Inc. for the Julia Yates Semmes Branch Library at Comanche Lookout Park in the amount of \$220,000.00 was approved by City Council on November 21, 2002, through Ordinance No. 96782. Subsequent Change Orders have increased the contract amount by \$75,000.00. This ordinance will increase the total authorized for this professional services agreement to \$316,272.60.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project provides for the construction of a new 15,875 square foot Branch Library to include site development and the required utilities. This facility and related improvements are located on a 6.6-acre site with a portion of the Comanche Lookout Park fronting Judson Road at Nacogdoches. Project construction began in June of 2004 and will be completed in April of 2006.

This ordinance authorizes Change Order 19 (final), in the amount of \$29,457.98, which is a final reconciliation and calculation of the original material quantities versus the actual quantities used by FMG Constructing Co., L.L.C., to complete the project. Change Order 19 is incorporated herein as Attachment 2.

### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 1999 General Obligation Library Improvement Bond, 1999 General Obligation Park Improvement Bond and Certificates of Obligation funded Capital Improvement Projects.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget not included in the FY 06-11 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$50,730.58 are available from the project's previously appropriated funds and are payable as follows:


