#### **SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION**

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the low bid submitted by Patriot Court Systems, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Parks and Recreation Department with labor, materials and equipment to resurface tennis courts located at the McFarlin Tennis Center for a total of \$63,240.00 and authorizes \$36,760.00 for park materials from General Fund One-Time Improvement Funds. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

A request for sealed bids was issued to provide the City of San Antonio Parks and Recreation Department with labor, materials and equipment to resurface the tennis courts at the McFarlin Tennis Center, located in San Pedro Park in City Council District 1. This project was funded through FY06 General Fund One-Time Improvement Funds. A total of six bids were received. The low bid was submitted by Patriot Court Systems, Inc. for a total of \$63,240.00. This bid was advertised in the Daily Commercial Recorder, La Prensa, the San Antonio Observer, the City of San Antonio Purchasing Website, Public Access Channel 21 and Demandstar.com.

The existing 21 courts at McFarlin Tennis Center, which include the tournament stadium, are in need of renovation and resurfacing. The bid improvements will allow for tennis court repairs, new surfacing, and markings needed for tournament requirements and general tennis operations. Also, the ordinance authorizes \$36,760.00 for park materials, which will be utilized by the park construction crew or small contractors to complete additional infrastructure improvements at McFarlin Tennis Center, including shade covers, landscaping and/or building improvements.

The United States Tennis Association (USTA) awarded San Antonio Tennis Association the bid for the Texas Adult Sectionals Sanctioned Tournament for 2006-2007. This award is contingent on repairing the tennis courts at the McFarlin Tennis Center, which currently do not meet the standards required by the USTA. In their restored condition, the courts will qualify to hold this tournament. In past years, the tournament has hosted approximately 800 players from around the country during the three day event.

The project will begin upon award by City Council and will be completed in March 2006, which meets the USTA time deadline of April 1, 2006 for improvements.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

This contract will provide labor, materials and equipment to resurface tennis courts located at the McFarlin Tennis Center. These improvements are expected to last a minimum of ten years. The contractor shall provide a one year labor and material warranty. The improvements will qualify the Center to meet national tournament standards.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

FY06 General Fund One-Time Improvement Funds of \$100,000.00 were approved for McFarlin Tennis Center. The total cost of this contract is \$63,240.00. Additional funds of \$36,760.00 will be utilized for park materials. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 Budget approved by City Council.
