SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the bids submitted by Recreational Consultants, All Play, and Miracle Recreation Equipment Company, WBE's, to provide the Parks and Recreation Department with playground equipment for Kingsborough, Royalgate, South San, and Golden Community Parks along with rubberized floor and skateboard equipment for construction at Medina Base Road Park, utilizing the Texas BuyBoard Contract for a total cost of \$198,354.60. Of which, \$74,274.60 will be from the 30th Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund; and \$124,080.00 will be from the 2003-2007 Park Bond Fund. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 approved by City Council.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This purchase is in response to the public meetings held in the neighborhoods which proposed park improvements to City Council. Currently, a playground park exists at Golden Community Park which is approximately 10 years old. The equipment in this park is targeted for children over the age of 5. The new playground will accommodate children between the ages of 2 to 12. This playground will consist of loop ladders, pod climbers, arch bridges with guardrails and a thunder climber. The skate park will have 9 obstacles for skateboarders to enjoy.

Additionally, three sets of playground equipment will be installed at Kingsborough, Royalgate and South San Parks. Equipment installed at these locations includes a tot rock climber, typhoon slides, mogul slides, spider climbers, bongo slides and lookout tower. All the equipment to be purchase will meet American with Disabilities Act (ADA) and U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) requirements.

The playground equipment and skate park equipment will be installed by Parks and Recreation staff and the rubberized fall zone material will be poured at the Golden Community Park by the vendor, All Play.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The playground equipment and the skate park equipment is estimated to last approximately 20 years with a 15 year warranty against structural failed caused by defective materials or workmanship. The rubberized pourable material is estimated to last approximately 15 years with a 3 year warranty against defective materials or workmanship.

This purchase is being made utilizing the Texas BuyBoard Contract #204-04 and will be in accordance with the Interlocal Participation Agreement with the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative Ordinance No. 97097. This cooperative is administered by the Texas Municipal League (TML). The products and services that are part of this cooperative have been competitively bid and awarded by the Cooperative's Board of Trustees based on Texas Statutes.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total cost of this contract is \$198,354.60. Of which, \$74,274.60 will be from the 30th Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fund; and \$124,080.00 will be from the 2003-2007 Park Bond Fund. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2005-2006 approved by City Council.
