SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low, qualified bid by RST Construction, Inc., a SBE/MBE firm, to perform construction work in connection with the Normoyle Park Community Center Repairs Project located at 700 Culberson Street in City Council District 5 for the base bid amount of \$54,303.00, with bid alternate 1 of \$2,900.00 and bid alternate 2 of \$3,100.00, for a total contract amount of \$60,303.00; authorizes the execution of a standard construction contract; allocates \$12,575.75 for construction contingency, \$500.00 for consultant contingency, \$1,717.15 for environmental costs, \$4,392.92 for bid advertising and printing, and \$1,310.78 for park materials; authorizes appropriations of \$40,799.60 from 2003 CDBG Reprogrammed funds and \$40,000.00 from 2006 Certificates of Obligation funds; and provides for payment.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project will provide repairs to the Normoyle Park Community Center located at 700 Culberson Street in City Council District 5. Improvements will include cleaning, washing and repairing the exterior CMU façade wall, replacing gutter down-spouts, roof flashing, environmental abatement of window sealant, clear story window/wall repairs, and contingent improvements. Debra J. Dockery, Architect, P.C., has completed the architectural plans associated with this project.

The construction bid was advertised the fourth and fifth week in March 2006 and the first and second week in April 2006 in the <u>Commercial Recorder</u>, <u>San Antonio Informer</u>, and <u>La Prensa De San Antonio</u>. Three (3) qualified bids were received and RST Construction, Inc., a SBE/MBE firm, was selected with the low base bid of \$54,303.00 and low bid alternates 1 and 2 of \$6,000.00 for a total amount of \$60,303.00. A standard construction contract will be executed. A summary of the bids is shown on Exhibit 1. The firm has no current City projects. The construction contract is for forty-five (45) calendar days. It is anticipated that the construction work will begin in July 2006 and will be completed in September 2006.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The construction contract was advertised and selected in accordance with established bid procedures.

FISCAL IMPACT

This project is listed in the FY2006-2011 adopted annual capital budget. A total of \$9,200.40 was previously encumbered for consultant and environmental assessment fees and for bid advertising and printing. The proposed ordinance will appropriate \$40,799.60 from 2003 CDBG Reprogrammed funds and \$40,000.00 from 2006 Certificates of Obligation funds. The project will utilize \$60,303.00 for construction contract, \$12,575.75 for construction contingency, \$500.00 for consultant contingency fees, \$1,717.15 for environmental costs, \$4,392.92 for bid advertising and printing, and \$1,310.78 for park materials. There will be no impact to the General Fund budget.

COORDINATION

The project has been coordinated with the Housing and Community Development Department, the Public Works Department, the Environmental Services Department, the Development Services Department, the Finance Department and the Office of Management and Budget.


