SUBJECT: Acceptance of a Federal Aviation Administration Grant in an amount of \$5,000,000.00 for San Antonio International Airport

DATE: June 29, 2006

SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

An ordinance authorizing the acceptance of an Airport Improvement Program grant from the Federal Aviation Administration, in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 in support of the Acoustical Treatment Program at the San Antonio International Airport.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City has applied and been approved for a grant in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 with the Federal Aviation Administration under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) in support of projects that are eligible for this grant.

The continuation of the Acoustical Treatment Program with grant funding of \$5,000,000.00 covers the cost for the treatment of an estimated 120 homes, bringing the total estimated funded homes to 420. Total grant funds to date, including this offer, is \$19,286,503 bringing the total program value to \$24,108,129 with matching funds. In order to fund this grant, the Federal Aviation Administration must have the accepted, fully executed grant in their possession no later than August 18, 2006.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The acceptance of this grant continues the policy of utilizing federal funds when available.

FISCAL IMPACT


This action has no fiscal impact. Appropriation of grants and airport matching funds for engineering and construction fees will be brought forward in subsequent ordinances. Matching share funds are included in the Aviation Department's 5 year Capital Improvement Program.




